Who this information is for

This information is for pupils (“you”) and parents or carers of those pupils

Understanding progress in the 2020/21 Academic Year

This work is being conducted by the Department for Education (DfE) to understand progress in education in the 2020/21 academic year and beyond, given the impact of the coronavirus pandemic.

How the DfE will use personal information

Your school currently collects information about you and your learning, some of which is collected for your school by Renaissance Learning. The DfE will use this information to understand academic progress in the 2020/21 Academic Year.

Who personal information will be shared with

The DfE also shares information with a contracted third party (EPI) who undertake analysis work on behalf of the DfE.

Why we can use personal information

To use personal information, we need to meet one condition specified under data protection legislation. The DfE uses and shares personal information as part of its public task function, which is one of the specified conditions.

How long we hold personal information

It is currently anticipated that this work to understand academic progress in the 2020/21 Academic Year will run until the 15th of October 2021, after which the personal data, supplied by Renaissance Learning will be securely destroyed.

Your rights
