

Implementation Phase 2: Expand your impact

During this phase of implementation, you may wish to focus on the following target(s):

- Star test your students at least once per term
- 100% participation in Accelerated Reader each half-term
- Aim for an Average Percent Correct of 85% or higher in quiz taking
- Competition idea: Reward the class which achieves the highest average percentage correct.

Once the initial training is completed, professional development continues through regular free workshops that are offered across the country and remote one hour webinars.
